Petitioner-Gurpreet Singh @ Gopi has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.22 dated 01.04.2017, registered at Police Station Valtaha, Tarn Taran, under Sections 302, 307, 452, 506, 427, 148 and 149 of IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

It is a case of double murder and two more persons have also been injured with fire-arm injuries. Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence and in view of the fact that the petitioner is required for custodial interrogation, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

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Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
