AMOL RATTAN SINGH, J. (Oral)

Pursuant to the order dated 26.4.2017, Mr.Mehta, on instructions from ASI Paramjit Singh, submits that three FIRs have been registered against petitioner no.1, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 323/324 etc. of the IPC, in one of which he was acquitted, in the other case a cancellation report was filed and the third one is under investigation. However, the other 7 petitioners, i.e. the other accused in the FIR in question, have no criminal antecedents.

Keeping in view the aforesaid and the fact that the matter has been compromised between the parties, in respect of which their statements have also been recorded before the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Hoshiarpur, who has sent his report dated 9.2.2017 to this Court, stating therein that the compromise effected between the petitioners and respondents no.2 and 3 appears to be voluntary and without any pressure or coercion, in the interest of peace and harmony, it is considered appropriate that the FIR in question be quashed along with all other subsequent

proceedings arising therefrom.

Ordered accordingly.

The petition is disposed of.
