The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking bail in FIR No.682 dated 12.10.2016 registered under Sections 307, 506 read with Section 34 IPC and Section 27 of the Arms Act at Police Station Civil Lines Hisar, District Hisar.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

The petitioner was arrested in this FIR on 12.10.2016 and since then he is in jail. Admittedly, the challan has been filed before the competent court.

Looking to the allegation against the petitioner that he had brought his licensed pistol and fired at the complainant but the direction was changed and as a result the shot missed the target. Be that as it may. In the absence of any criminal record against the petitioner and the fact

that the trial will take its own time, I am inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. hence I make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) The CRL. MISC. No.M-453 OF 2017 is allowed.
- (ii) The petitioner be released on bail to the satisfaction of the CJM/Duty Magistrate, Hisar.
- (iii) The petitioner shall not tamper or influence the prosecution witness(es).
- (iv) In case of violation of the above condition the liberty is reserved to apply for cancellation of bail.
