In this petition, anticipatory bail to the petitioner, Lakhwinder Singh, is sought on the ground that he was found innocent by the investigating agency and in fact has been summoned by the learned trial Court on an application having been moved under Section 319 Cr.P.C., which having been dismissed, however, that order was reversed by this Court in CRM-M-7065-2016 on 24.09.2016 (Annexure P-1).

It is seen that the same Bench that had directed that the petitioner and his co-accused be summoned in response to the application under Section 319 Cr.P.C, has already admitted the petitioner to interim bail in this petition, vide an order dated 23.12.2016, obviously for the reason that the investigating agency in any case having found to the petitioner to be

innocent, no custodial interrogation is required.

Consequently, the aforesaid order dated 23.12.2016, is made absolute on the same terms and conditions.
