Petitioners seek issuance of necessary directions to the respondents No.1 to 3 for cancellation of FIR allegedly got recorded by respondent No.10 after inflicting self-suffered injuries on himself after inflicting injuries on the petitioners.

The petitioners also pray for issuance of direction to convert the DDR No.28 got recorded by the petitioners into FIR. Besides the aforesaid prayer, transfer of investigation and protection of the petitioners from respondents No.8 to 16 are also sought.

Before going into the prayers of the petitioners, it would be seen that precisely for the grievance in issue,

petitioner No.1 Nazar Singh has already filed a representation to the respondent No.3.

At this stage, it would be just and appropriate to direct respondent No.3 to look into the grievance of the petitioners and pass appropriate orders in the context of prayers made by the petitioners in this petition.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an opinion on the merits of the case.

Respondent No.3 would be obligated to look into the allegations without being influenced by any other consideration.
