Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners having suffered injuries allegedly at the hands of respondent no.4 and a complaint having been filed in that regard to the Deputy Superintendent of Police having jurisdiction over Police Station Jandiala Guru, District Amritsar, no action has been taken thereupon.

He further submits that at this stage, the petitioners would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent no.2, to take appropriate action.

Consequently, without commenting on the merits of the allegations against respondent no.4, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, to ensure that the lives and liberty of the petitioners are duly protected and to take action as is warranted under the law.

In case the jurisdiction over the area concerned is not with the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, he would then forward the complaint to

the SSP concerned, who would then look into the matter and would take action as per law, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
