Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.235 dated 27.06.2014, registered under Sections 21/22/29/85 of the NDPS Act and offence under Sections 379/411 IPC at Police Station Civil Lines, Amritsar City.

Petitioner along with co-accused was over powered by the Police. Total 400 grams of intoxicated powder was recovered from the car of the petitioner and other co-accused. Ad interim bail was granted to the petitioner on 15.10.2014. During the period of interim bail, petitioner was arrested in some other case, resultantly he did not appear in the trial Court.

Evidently, report of the Chemical Examiner has been received in which diphenoxylate hydrochloride was found in the sample of contraband. The recovery is found to be commercial in nature.

In view of aforesaid, I do not see any ground to revive the interim bail granted to the petitioner. Petition is accordingly dismissed. Petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law.
