Mr. Manmeet S. Rana, Advocate for the petitioner has provided details of the civil suit pertaining to the accused-Balwinder Singh which is pending in the Court at Jalandhar to the learned State Counsel, who submits that all endeavours shall be made to arrest the accused. As the main contention of the State Counsel is that on account of the fact that lone accused is unavailable, the proceedings have been put to hold though process of declaring him to be a proclaimed offender is underway and has assured that suitable action would be initiated preferably within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner on instructions from his client wishes to withdraw the present petition however, reserving rights of the petitioner to invoke jurisdiction of this Court on the same very grounds in case of any future eventuality, within the framework of law.
