Pursuant to the order dated 23.12.2016, by which the petitioner was ordered to be admitted to interim anticipatory bail subject to her complying with all conditions stipulated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C., with that order being continued on 07.03.2017, learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Parveen Kumar, submits that the petitioner has submitted the document that was required to be submitted by her. However, he submits that the petitioners' complicity cannot be over looked, inasmuch as, she even signed as Gurbachan Kaur in the passport office, where a photograph of her was taken, on an application for a passport.

Without making any comment on the merits of the case of the petitioner, or against her, keeping in view the fact that she is admittedly 70 years old and with the document having been recovered from her presently her custodial interrogation is not required, the order dated 23.12.2016 is

made absolute on the same terms and conditions.
