The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 282 dated 08.08.2017, under Section 20 of Narcotics Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, registered at Police Station Murthal, District Sonapat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that 800 grams of Charas is allegedly recovered from him, which is below the threshold of commercial quantity of 01 kg. He further contends that the petitioner is in custody for almost four months since his arrest on 08.08.2017 and is not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Ashok Kumar states that the investigation has been completed and the matter is now fixed before the trial Court for framing of charges.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when the petitioner has been in custody for almost four months and alleged recovery is less than the threshold of commercial quantity and he is not involved in any other case, I deem it appropriate to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. Petitioner, namely, Kiran Pal is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
