Petitioner-Santosh Mishra with Mr. Aman Kashyap Advocate and respondent-Sanjeev Kumar Singh, who has been identified by Ms. Divya Sharma, Advocate have been present in person and made a statement before this Court that they have settled their dispute arising out of the cheque in question and placed on record the compromise in original, so effected consisting of 04 pages. Both the parties have reiterated their stand *qua* this compromise and have satisfied the Court that for all times to come, they have put an end to this dispute *inter se* them.

The complainant/respondent has made a statement that he has no objection if the judgments of conviction passed by the two Courts below dated 19.11.2010/20.11.2010 and 01.12.2011, respectively, are quashed, which is vouched by the appellant's side.

In the light of the same and in view of the statements made by the parties, necessitates intervention by this Court to allow the present

revision petition as well as in view of law laid down in “*G. Sivarajan Vs. Little Flower Kuries and Enterprises Ltd. & another* 2005(9) SCALE 597”, judgment of conviction dated 19.11.2010 and order of sentence dated 20.11.2010 passed by the Court of Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Gurgaon and subsequent judgment dated 01.12.2011 passed by Additional Sessions Judge, Gurgaon are hereby set aside and the appellant stands acquitted of the charges, so framed against him.
