Quashing of FIR No.112 dated 01.12.2015 under Sections 406/498-A and 323 IPC, at Police Station Sadar Sangrur, District Sangrur, is being sought on the basis of compromise deed dated 03.10.2016(P-3).

Respondent No.2 got married to petitioner No.1 on 15.02.2015. Due to temperamental differences, both the parties could not live together as husband and wife. The relationship between them became strained and F.I.R. was registered against the petitioners on account of harassment caused to the respondent on the pretext of bringing less dowry.

However, the matter has now been duly compromised, vide compromise deed dated 03.10.2016 (P-3).

In compliance of order dated 09.01.2017, report dated 18.02.2017 of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sangrur, has been received in this regard. As per report, statement of parties have been

recorded. The complainant stated that the matter stands compromised between the parties and she does not want to proceed further against the accused and has no objection, if the present F.I.R. be quashed against the petitioners. The compromise has been entered voluntarily. To the same effect is the joint statement given by accused-petitioners Hardeep Dass, Janak Dass, Rajwinder Kaur and Jagtar Singh.

Consequently, in view of the status report dated 18.02.2017 and in view of the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of ***Dr. Arvind Barsaul etc. versus State of Madhya Pradesh and another 2008(2) RCR (Criminal) 910***, no useful purpose would be served in prolonging the litigation.

Accordingly, FIR No.112 dated 01.12.2015 under Sections 406/498-A and 323 IPC, at Police Station Sadar Sangrur, District Sangrur, is quashed along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom qua petitioners.

The petition stands disposed of.
