The petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.23 dated 15.2.2017, under Section 15-29/61/85 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Balachaur, District Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar.

The allegations in nutshell are that on 15.2.2017 when the police party signaled the car in which the present petitioner was driving, to stop, while the petitioner immediately upon halting the car ran away from the spot, the other two occupants of the car namely Raj Kumar and Sukhraj were apprehended and upon search of the car three bags containing poppy husk total containing 54 kilograms were recovered.

The other two accused who had been apprehended at the spot have already been granted bail by Co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide orders dated 15.9.2017 and 14.9.2017.

In view of the aforesaid position especially that the accused was not arrested at the spot and also on the grounds of parity, in my opinion, it is a fit case for grant of bail. The petition accordingly merits acceptance and is hereby accepted . The petitioner-Kuldeep Singh @ Bhuri is directed to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
