Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has already joined investigation in compliance of interim bail granted by this Court. It is further submitted that she is ready to face proceedings, in accordance with law.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Balwinder Singh, concedes to this position and further admitted the fact that the complainant and her husband had been residing separately from the present petitioner. He has further informed the Court that the husband was arrested in the case and released on bail.

In view of the above, interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 23.12.2016 is made absolute subject to the following

conditions:-

- (i) She shall join the investigation as and when required by the Investigating Officer.
- (ii) She shall not offer any threat, promise or inducement to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing the same to the Investigating Officer/Court; and
- (iii) She shall not leave the limits of this country without prior permission of the Court.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
