Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has already joined investigation in compliance with interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 23.12.2016 and is ready to face the proceedings, in accordance with law, without any default. It is further submitted that there is no allegation in the FIR with regard to harassment or cruelty in connection with demand of dowry but the complainant has levelled allegation that husband of the complainant is under the influence of his elder brothers who are exploiting the position.

Counsel for the State has conceded to the position that the petitioner has already joined investigation.

In view of the above, the petition stands disposed of. Interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 23.12.2016 is made absolute subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) he shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;
- (ii) he shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- (iii) he shall not leave India without the previous permission of the Court.
