Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.23 dated 28.01.2014, under Sections 15/61/85 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Salem Tabri, District Ludhiana.

As per prosecution version, an alleged recovery of 18 bags of poppy husk containing 30 kgs. each i.e. 5 quintals 40 kgs. of poppy husk was effected from the petitioner as also co-accused.

Such alleged recovery would be construed as commercial quantity.

That apart State counsel has apprised the Court that the petitioner is a habitual offender and is involved in four other proceedings under the NDPS Act.

This Court is not inclined to accept the prayer made by the petitioner for grant of bail.

Petition dismissed.
