INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner-Ravi Kumar @ Lala has filed this 3rd petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.674 dated 01.10.2014, registered at Police Station Jhajjar, District Jhajjar, under Sections 148, 149, 307, 302 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

In the second petition filed by the petitioner, which was decided by this Court on 11.08.2017, this Court held that as per the order

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dated 22.02.2017 passed by this Court in CRM-M-4771-2017, a liberty was granted to the petitioner to approach this Court afresh after the deposition of the complainant-Neeraj and his uncle Dharam Singh is concluded. Now the statement of Dharam Singh has already been recorded whereas complainant-Neeraj has been examined-in-chief only and his cross-examination has not been conducted so far and his statement is not concluded yet.

Therefore, in view of the directions of this Court, the present petition filed by the petitioner is pre-mature and the same is dismissed.

However, the petitioner is at liberty to file fresh petition after the cross-examination of PW Neeraj.
