Petitioner-Jasbir alias Bablu has filed this 2nd petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.07 dated 17.01.2015, registered at Police Station Baragudha, District Sirsa, under Sections 21-B and 22-B of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

Notice of motion. On the asking of Court, Mr. Deep Singh, AAG, Punjab has accepted notice on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the allegation in the FIR, 160 vials of Rexcof weighing 100 ml. each were recovered from the present petitioner. The aforesaid recovery falls in commercial quantity. Section 37 of the NDPS Act bars the benefit of bail to accused in case of commercial quantity.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
