Insofar as petitioner No.1-Major Singh is concerned. Petitioner No.1 has joined the investigation, and his custody is no more required as stated by learned counsel for the State, on instructions from Head Constable Sukhwinder Singh. Hence, the order dated January 11, 2017 granting anticipatory bail is made absolute qua petitioner No.1-Major Singh only.

Insofar as, petitioner No.2-Rajesh Kumar is concerned. The allegations against the petitioner are serious, in as much as the petitioner has alleged to have given *kirpan blow*, resulting into fracture of right hand of the complainant-Narinder Pal.

Petition for grant of anticipatory bail is rejected qua petitioner No.2-Rajesh Kumar and he is at liberty to apply for regular bail.
