The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in cross case bearing DDR No.17 dated 11.09.2016 registered under Sections 307, 324, 148 & 149 IPC in case FIR No.64 dated 08.09.2016 registered under Sections 307, 148 & 149 IPC read with Section 25, 27 of Arms Act at Police Station Tarsika, District Amritsar Rural.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Learned counsel appearing for the complainant submits that indeed the compromise has been arrived at between the parties and the complainant has no grievance if the petitioner is granted bail.
