By filing the present petition, under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought regular bail in FIR No. 87 dated 06.11.2016, registered under Sections 307, 148 read with Section 149 of IPC and Sections 25 & 27 of Arms Act, at Police Station Phase-8, District Mohali.

It is contended that the petitioner is not named in the FIR whereas co-accused, Bhupinder Kumar and Sonu Shah who are main accused and named in the FIR have been admitted to bail by the learned trial Court. The petitioner is in custody since 08.11.2016.

On the other hand, learned State counsel opposes the bail application, however, he is unable to controvert the assertion with regard to the bail orders qua co-accused, Bhupinder Kumar and Sonu

Shah.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

Considering the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 08.11.2016; the named co-accused who played active role have been enlarged on bail; the challan is yet to be presented, therefore, it can be safely inferred that the trial is not likely to be concluded in the near future, without adverting to the merits of the instant case, this petition is allowed. The petitioner be admitted to bail during the pendency of trial, on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds, to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Anything said herein above shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
