The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No.74, dated 28.04.2015, under Sections 420/506/120-B IPC, registered at Police Station City South Moga, District Moga qua the present petitioner.

Having argued the matter at some length, counsel prays for withdrawal of the petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

It is, however, made clear that dismissal of the present petition as withdrawn would not preclude the petitioner from raising all pleas that may be available to her in accordance with law at the appropriate stage and before the appropriate forum.

Furthermore, in the light of the submissions made by counsel that the petitioner is a young girl and is a student, in the eventuality of any application being preferred before the trial Court seeking exemption from personal appearance, the same would be considered sympathetically.
