Prayer made in the instant petition is, inter alia, for issuance of direction to respondent Nos.1 and 2 to initiate departmental and criminal proceedings under Section 166A IPC against respondent No.4 for not acting upon the complaint (Annexure P-1) moved by the petitioner.

Contentends that a 'Zero FIR' was registered at Women Police Station, Ambala. However, for lack of jurisdiction, the entire case file has now been sent to Police Station, Lalru.
