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DEEPAK SIBAL, J.(ORAL)

Through the present petition, quashing of FIR No.248, dated 09.08.2015, registered under Sections 379-B IPC, at Police Station City Khanna, Punjab (Annexure P-1) is sought for on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

Through order of this Court dated 09.01.2017, the parties were directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate to get their statements recorded, who in turn was directed to send a report to this Court with regard to the genuineness of the compromise arrived at between the parties.

As directed, report dated 21.01.2017 from the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Khanna, has been received, as per which the parties recorded their statements before the trial Court in terms of the compromise arrived at between them.

Learned State counsel has also raised no objection.

In view of the above, continuation of the proceedings in pursuance of the afore-referred FIR would be an abuse of the process of law and in terms of the law laid down by the Full Bench of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh and others versus State of Haryana and others, 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, I deem it just and proper to allow the petition and resultantly quash the FIR No.248, dated 09.08.2015, registered under Sections 379-B IPC, at Police Station City Khanna, Punjab (Annexure P-1) and all proceedings arising therefrom.
