In the instant writ petition, the petitioner has sought following reliefs: -

“a. issue a writ, order or direction in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to pay full salary to the petitioner as is being paid to other similarly situated Class-IV employees and to release all the arrears alongwith 12% interest from the due date till the same are actually paid;”

In this regard, he has submitted representation and approached the concerned respondent and so also issued legal notice. No action has been taken by the concerned respondent. Matter is pending consideration since 2008. Therefore, the concerned respondent is hereby directed to take a decision on the petitioner's legal notice and pass a speaking order while considering petitioner's claim. Concerned respondent is hereby directed to consider order passed in ***CWP No. 14796 of 2003, Avtar Singh V/s. State of Punjab and others*** and so also decision passed in ***Civil Appeal No. 213 of 2013*** decided on 26.10.2016 ***State of Punjab and others V/s. Jagjit Singh and others*** (Para 57 and 58). Speaking order shall be passed within a

period of 10 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
