Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.486, dated 28.11.2014, under Sections 21/61/85 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station A-Division, Amritsar City, District Amritsar.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

As per prosecution version, an alleged recovery of 70 gms contraband was effected from the petitioner. Report of the chemical examiner shows the same to be containing diphenoxylate. Such recovery would be construed as commercial in nature.

In view of the specific bar contained under Section 37 of NDPS Act, this Court would not be inclined to accept the prayer for grant of bail.

Petition is dismissed.
