The prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in FIR No.293 dated 13.12.2015 for the offence under Sections 304-B IPC, registered at Police Station Chheharta, Amritsar.

Petitioner is in custody since 06.04.2016. As per allegation in the FIR, sister-in-law of the petitioner committed suicide in her parental house on 13.12.2015.

Learned State counsel submits that husband of the deceased has been declared as proclaimed offender vide order dated 31.05.2016 as he is residing at Italy. Mother-in-law of the deceased and wife of the petitioner were granted anticipatory bail vide orders dated 01.12.2016 (Annexure P-11) and 18.07.2016 (Annexure P-10) respectively. He further submits that out of 33 witnesses, none has been examined so far. Vide order dated 03.03.2007, one last opportunity was granted to the trial Court to examine the complainant but he has not been examined till today.

In view of the above and considering the fact that trial will not mature in near future, petitioner be released on regular bail on furnishing their fresh bail bonds/sureties to the satisfaction of Duty Magistrate/Illaqa Magistrate, Amritsar.
