The petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No. 111 dated 26.05.2014 under Sections 376, 366, 354-A, 511, 506, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Lalru, District S.A.S. Nagar along with subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

It is averred in the petition that despite the FIR having been registered in May 2014, final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C was not presented and the present was in fact a case of run away marriage. Learned counsel for the State was directed to seek instructions with regard to the status of the proceedings.

As per reply dated 06.07.2017 filed on behalf of respondent No. 1 it is mentioned that final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. was presented on 01.05.2017. Statement of the prosecutrix was recorded under Section 164 Cr.P.C. She has reiterated the version as given in the complaint. It is informed that this matter is listed before the learned trial Court for framing of charges for 12.09.2017.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw this petition with liberty to raise all the pleas available to the petitioner before the learned trial Court at the appropriate stage.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
