Perused the reply filed by Manmohan Singh Aulakh, PPS,
Deputy Superintendent of Police, Investigation Amritsar (Rural).

The trial Court has in para 2 states thus about the role of the
petitioner:

“2. The cross version has been registered on statement made by Gurminder Singh @ Bittu. According to the cross version, Sukhdev Singh armed with gun 12 bore, Davinder Singh and Harvinder Singh armed with a pistol each, Jagdeep Singh, Shera Sarpanch, Sahib Singh Munshi, Kaka Shah and Karanbir Singh empty handed along with 20-26 persons had come to the spot. After Sukhdev Singh raised lalkara, the above named persons started firing. Gurminder Singh received gun shot

injury on his right foot, who was shifted to Guru Nanak Dev Hospital.”

In view of the above, there is *prima facie* case made out against the petitioner who is not entitled to grant of anticipatory bail. The petition is therefore, dismissed.

Order dated 27.12.2016, granting anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is vacated.
