The petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.119 dated 10.10.2016, under Sections 307, 148 and 148 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 25/27/54/59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Bhikhiwind, District Tarn Taran.

The allegations, in nutshell, are that on 10.10.2016, when the police party was holding Nakabandi, then one Innova car bearing registration No.PB-04-S-4977 was signaled to stop, but the driver of the car instead of stopping the car tried to escape through the barricades by speeding the car. However, the car got imbalanced. Two of the occupants of that car namely Gurdit Singh and Sagar were apprehended at the spot, while the remaining four managed to escape. It is not disputed that all other co-accused are on regular bail.

The petitioner has been behind bars since the last more than

one year. The trial in its normal course is not likely to be concluded in immediate future. As such no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind bars for an indefinite period.

The petition for bail is accepted. The petitioner-Sukhdev Singh @ Sukhu @ Daddu is directed to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
