SUDIP AHLUWALIA, J. (ORAL)

In this petition, the petitioner seeks her release on regular bail in F.I.R. No.110, dated 06.05.2017, under Sections 148, 149, 302/120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Salhawas, District Jhajjar.

2. The petitioner has remained in custody for seven months now. The incriminating material against her happens to be her own disclosure statement as well as that of her own daughter-in-law, who is also a co-accused.

3. On going through the same, it is clear that the actual acts of

violence upon the deceased-victim were attributable to the male members of the family.

4. For this reason and considering the long detention of the petitioner, who is a woman, at this stage, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner, namely Sudesh wife of Umed, is directed to be released on regular bail subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court.

5. Nothing expressed in this order shall, however, be construed as any observation on the merits of the case, particularly qua the male accused persons.
