FIR No.415 dated 01.10.2010 under Section 229A IPC was drawn up in Police Station Division No.5, Civil Lines, Ludhiana City in compliance of order No.284 passed by the Court of the Ld. Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Ludhiana.

It transpires that the particular criminal proceeding in which the order was passed by the Ld. Magistrate, directing registration of the FIR has itself been quashed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court in CRM-M-25914 & CRM-M-33021 of 2014 by a detailed reasoned order passed on 14.12.2015.

In the given circumstances, the FIR registered subsequently on account of an order passed in the defunct proceedings itself becomes redundant since the contesting parties have otherwise amicably settled their dispute.

For the aforesaid reasons, this petition is allowed.

Resultantly, FIR No. 415 dated 01.10.2010 under Section 229A IPC which was drawn up in Police Station Division No.5, Civil Lines, Ludhiana City with its subsequent proceedings are ordered to be quashed forthwith.

Petition stands allowed.
