Petitioner-Ashok Kumar, has filed this petition under Section 482 of Code of Criminal Procedure praying for quashing of FIR No.106, dated 04.05.2015, registered at Police Station Pinjore, District Panchkula, under Sections 406 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom in view of the compromise.

Notice of motion was issued in this case with a direction to the parties to appear before the learned trial Court for getting their statements recorded in support of the compromise.

After doing the needful, learned Sub Divisional Magistrate, Kalka, has sent report dated 20.12.2017. In the report, it is stated that compromise as such has not been effected between the parties. Statement of complainant was sent in original along with the report.

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Keeping in view fact since the respondent No.2/complainant
has stated that at this stage there is no compromise between the parties,
therefore, no ground is made out to allow the instant petition.

Therefore, finding no merit in the instant petition, the same is
dismissed.
