Through the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr. P. C., the petitioner seeks the concession of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 273, dated 25.11.2016, registered under Section 420 IPC, at Police Station City Rajpura, District Patiala.

The allegations, in brief, against the petitioner are that he being salesman of one Goyal Automobiles gave a quotation of Rs.7,76,594/-which was forged.

Vide order dated 29.12.2016, while issuing notice of motion, this Court had granted the concession of ad-interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner to the satisfaction of the arresting officer.

At the very outset, learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gurnam Singh submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and is no longer required for any further questioning by the prosecution.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the order dated 29.12.2016 granting ad-interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

Nothing observed herein-above shall be considered to be an expression of opinion by this Court on the merits of the case.
