SHEKHER DHAWAN, J.

Present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 5 dated 15.1.2017, under Sections 323, 324, 326, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Bholath, District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and the main injury under Section 326 IPC has not been attributed to him and the co-accused, namely; Rajesh Khanna has already joined the investigation and admitted to bail. The petitioner is in custody in this case since 10.9.2017.

Learned State counsel affirms that co-accused, namely; Rajesh Khanna, Lakhwinder Pal @ Lakhwinder Singh, Nav Yugraj Khanna @ Nav Yograj Khanna and Satish Kumar @ Sabi had joined investigation and they were admitted to bail.

Having considered the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties and the facts that the petitioner is in custody since 10.9.2017; the main injury was not attributed to the present petitioner; the trial of the case still to take some more time and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bars, the present petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The present petition stands disposed of.
