The present petition has been filed under Section 438
Cr.P.C seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 147 dated 08.12.2016
registered under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC at Police Station Women
Police Station, Ludhiana City.

On 30.05.2017 this Court had passed the following
order:-

“Mediation has failed. Adjourned to 16.8.2017. In the meantime,
the petitioner shall again join investigation on 4.7.2017 at 10-00
a.m. to get effect recovery of articles claimed by the complainant
though counsel for the petitioner would state that she has taken
away all articles of dowry. ”

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Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 30.05.2017.

Learned State counsel informs that though, the petitioner has joined the investigation however, the recovery of approximately 94 gms of gold entrusted to the petitioner has not been effected.

The petitioner undertakes either to return the gold articles or to pay amount equivalent to 94 gms of gold.

In view of the undertaking, the order dated 30.05.2017 passed by this Court is made absolute, subject to furnishing of bail-bonds/surety bonds by the petitioner to the satisfaction of the CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
