The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.257, dated 13.12.2016, under Sections 420/120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur.

An application has been moved on behalf of the petitioner seeking withdrawal of the instant petition on the ground that the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur has entrusted an inquiry to the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Dhuri to look into the allegations made by the petitioner. It is prayed that the petitioner be permitted to withdraw the instant petition to await the outcome of such inquiry that has already been instituted.

Prayer is allowed.

The present petition is dismissed as not pressed with liberty to the petitioner to approach this Court afresh after furnishing the inquiry report. It is however clarified that by virtue of this order no protection as regards arrest has been granted by the Court.
