Counsel for the State concedes to this position and further states that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required.

In view of the above, the petition stands disposed of. Interim bail granted to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) she shall make herself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;
- (ii) she shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- (iii) she shall not leave India without the previous permission of the Court.
