Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos.4 and 5.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Ms. Ashima Mor, AAG, U.T., Chandigarh, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent Nos.1 to 3.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. They are stated to be major. At the time of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioners produced original marriage certificate and photocopy of the same is taken on record. In support of his proof of age, petitioner No.1 has placed on record a copy of Aadhar Card (Annexure P-1) wherein the date of his birth is mentioned as 3.7.1984, whereas petitioner No.2 has placed on record a copy of Secondary Examination Certificate (Annexure P-2) wherein her date of birth is mentioned as 14.11.1998. They have also moved a representation (Annexure P-4) before respondent No.2 – Senior

Superintendent of Police, U.T., Chandigarh for protection of their lives and liberty.

Without adverting to the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, U.T., Chandigarh to take appropriate action on the said representation.

This order has nothing to do with regard to validity or invalidity of the marriage of the petitioners.
