Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for quashing FIR No. 25 dated 25.01.2011, under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Zirakpur, District SAS Nagar.

Learned counsel for respondent No. 2 has produced the receipt of ₹ 11 lacs received from the petitioners. The same is taken on record. Learned counsel for respondent No. 2-complainant submits that respondent No. 2 has no objection if the aforesaid FIR is quashed. In view of the compromise between the parties on 07.11.2017, she further submits that the RSA filed by respondent No. 2 against the petitioners has already been withdrawn.

In view of compromise dated 07.11.2017 and considering the fact

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that the same will bring harmony in relations between the parties, FIR No. 25 dated 25.01.2011, under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of IPC, registered at Police Station Zirakpur, District Mohali, is quashed, subject to costs of ₹ 10,000/- to be deposited in State Legal Services Authority, Punjab.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.

Adjourned to 15.01.2018 for production of receipt qua deposit of costs.
