Though at the time when notice was issued on 13.02.2017, it was ordered to be returned on 15.05.2017 and thereafter, upon CRM-8319-2017 having been filed by respondents no. 4 to 7 stating that though they do not recognize the marriage of petitioners to each other but they would not interfere in their lives, notice had been issued in that application, returnable today.

In response to such notice, learned counsel for the petitioners has appeared and submitted that the petition itself may be disposed of in terms of the affidavit.

Consequently, the main case is taken up for hearing today itself.

On specific query, learned counsel for respondents no. 4 to 7 submits that the said respondents otherwise admit that there is no prohibited relationship between the petitioners and both the petitioners are of the age of majority, but since the said respondents are not happy with the marriage, they have disowned petitioner no. 1.

Be that as it may, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents no. 2 and 3 to continue to ensure that the life and liberty of the petitioners is duly protected, as per law.
