SHEKHER DHAWAN, J.

Present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 713 dated 10.9.2017, under Sections 381 and 406 IPC (Sections 408 & 201 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Camp Palwal, District Palwal.

Memorandum of Appearance filed on behalf of the complainant is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. Even a sum of Rs.80,000/- has been recovered from him and the alleged offences against the petitioner are triable by the Court of Magistrate. He is in custody since 17.9.2017 and trial of the case still to take some more time, so he be released on bail.

Learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for the

complainant opposed the bail petition on the ground that huge amount is involved in the present case and the petitioner misappropriate the amount, so his bail petition be dismissed.

Having considered the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties and the facts that the petitioner is in custody since 17.9.2017; the trial of the case still to take some more time and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bars, the present petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The present petition stands disposed of.
