In the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for issuance of a direction to respondents No. 2 and 3 to conduct fair and impartial investigation in the complaint as well as the reminders sent by the petitioner and to look into the grievances raised by the petitioner as contained in representation dated 28.06.2017 (Annexure P-3) and taken necessary legal action against respondent No. 4-Gurpreet Singh.
