Through this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, prayer has been made for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.373 dated 17.11.2017 registered under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short, 'the Act'), at Police Station City Sangrur, District Sangrur.

According to the prosecution, in the intervening night of 03/04.08.2017, the petitioner was deployed on the main entrance of the jail as PESCO employee and on search by the Deputy Superintendent, Jail-cum-Night Officer alongwith Assistant Superintendent, 148 intoxicant tablets and one black coloured mobile marka M.I. alongwith two SIM and battery in working condition were recovered from him. In this way, the petitioner committed jail offence by keeping in his possession working mobile phone and intoxicant tablets inside the jail which is in utter violation of jail rules.

Considering over all facts and circumstances and seeing the seriousness of the offence committed the petitioner, the petitioner does not deserve the benefit of concession of anticipatory bail. Hence, this petition is dismissed.
