TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.(ORAL)

This is the second petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.145 dated 27.11.2016, under Sections 341/324/323/34 of IPC, later on added Sections 325/326 of IPC, registered at Police Station Chhajli, District Sangrur.

Counsel for the petitioner has been heard.

FIR came to be registered on the statement of Chamkaur Singh in relation to an alleged occurrence that took place on 26.11.2016.

The specific attribution to the present petitioner is of being armed with a Gandasi and having inflicted injuries with the same on the head of the complainant.

The injuries suffered by the complainant stand corroborated from medical evidence and it has been opined that the injuries suffered on the head is grievous and thereby attracting offence under Section 326 IPC.

In the light of such specific attribution to the present petitioner and coupled

with the seriousness of the offence, this Court is not inclined to extend in his favour the concession of anticipatory bail.

Petition dismissed.
