Petitioner No. 1 and the respondent are present in person.

Petitioner No. 1 and the respondent have arrived at a consensus
and would state that the orders passed by the Courts below may be modified
in the following terms:-

- 1) The respondent shall pay maintenance to petitioner No. 1 @ Rs.7,000.00 per month from today i.e. 19.05.2017;
- 2) He shall incur entire expenses on education of the child (petitioner No. 2) till the time he continues his studies. The expenses includes fee (including admission charges etc.) payable to the College/Institution at any place within India, books, stationery, boarding and lodging. The fees, boarding and lodging charges would be paid

directly to the concerned authority. The petitioners would be at liberty to communicate with the respondent for doing the needful;

3) Petitioner No. 1 and the respondent undertake that they will not initiate any proceedings under Section 127 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for modification of order of maintenance etc.
