In the instant writ petition, the petitioners have questioned the validity of the letter/order dated 24.05.2005 passed by respondent No.3 by which order of regularization passed on earlier occasion has sought to be withdrawn. Admittedly, order dated 24.05.2005 has been passed without hearing the petitioner. In other words, not even show cause notice has been issued to the petitioner before withdrawing the order of regularization. Withdrawal of regularization has effect of civil consequence on the petitioner. Therefore, without hearing the petitioner the respondents have resorted to pass the order dated 24.05.2005. Hence, letter/order dated 24.05.2005 passed by respondent No.3 is hereby set aside. Reserving liberty to the respondents to proceed by issuing necessary notice containing reasons for withdrawal of the regularization etc.

Above exercise shall be completed by the respondents within a period of 4 months from today and communicate the speaking order to the petitioners.

CWP stands disposed of.
