Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in FIR No.129 dated 11.04.2017, under Sections 18/61/27-A/85 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substance Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Bhuna, District Fatehabad.

Learned State counsel fairly submits that there is no other case against the petitioner.

Having heard the learned counsel, I have perused the FIR. The FIR shows that the petitioner was the driver of the truck and the physical possession of the contraband was found with Baldev Singh.

In that view of the matter in the above background, it would not be appropriate to detain the petitioner any more since the trial will take its own time.

In that view of the matter, this petition is allowed.

Petitioner shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned. Petitioner shall surrender his passport, if possesses, with the trial Court. Petitioner shall not tamper, influence and threaten the prosecution witnesses and complainant as well. In case, the petitioner violates the above said conditions, this order of bail comes to an end automatically without reference to this Court.
