The prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for directing respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondent No.4.

Learned State counsel has filed reply by way of an affidavit of Sh. Krishan Kumar, Deputy Superintendent of Police, PPS, Sub-Division, Rajpura in Court today. The same is taken on record. As per the affidavit, the police has conducted a raid in the house of the petitioner for the arrest of one accused, namely, Nirmaljit Singh Nimma in FIR No.77 dated 07.09.2017, under Sections 302, 120-B IPC and 25 of the Arms Act at Police Station Banur. The petitioners are the maternal uncle and wife of said accused, namely, Nirmaljit Singh Nimma. It is further submits that neither the petitioners are required in the said FIR nor they were harassed.

In view of the above, this petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
