Petitioner-Amandeep Kumar alias Aman has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.238 dated 09.10.2017, registered at Police Station Shimlapuri, Ludhiana, under Section 379 of IPC and Sections 379-B, 411 and 473 of IPC.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that main allegation against the petitioner is regarding theft of motor-cycles.

The petitioner has been in custody since 09.10.2017. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in

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judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
